3-4 Year Olds

I cannot believe that we have already reached the end of the year and what an action packed half term it has been. The children have enjoyed learning about our big question, 'Where can we go on a journey?' We have been thinking carefully about where we have been and how we got there. We have also thought carefully about the journey that we may be going on to our new schools and how this might feel. The children have enjoyed transition visits to meet their new teachers and we have also enjoyed meeting their teachers in our school.

We brought our curriculum alive with a wonderful trip to the Storybarn where we made up stories, listened and shared new books, and enjoyed a sensory walk in Calderstones Park. We have also enjoyed creating new patterns following examples; recognising and ordering numerals to 5; and recognising that an amount remains the same no matter how the amount is arranged. The children are also becoming increasingly confident when linking sounds to letters and segmenting and blending in group games.

It has been so wonderful to see the progress that all the children have made this year and, although we will really miss those who are going to school, we know that they are ready for their new adventures. It would be lovely to see the children in their uniforms so please pop in and see us in the autumn term.
